
Golf Update

April 29th

We wanted to notify you that Effective Thursday, May 7th Members may bring up to 3 guests and **Corporate Members will be permitted to transfer** passes to guests/clients (maximum 3 per visit). Additionally, Friday, May 8th, the Harvest Golf Club with measures will begin accepting public play. From May 8th onward, pyramids on the driving range will be removed. The range building will be open, all golfers will be permitted to use drivers/tees. The chipping green, club washers, benches, and bag stands will remain unavailable until further notice. With the increased capacity, all range stalls will be available for use (all stalls are in excess of 10 feet apart & allowing proper social distancing). Our practice facility can be extremely busy at times and with more people hitting simultaneously, please be aware of your immediate surroundings as our range has historically been a very social area.

Effective Saturday, May 2nd power carts will be reequipped with scorecard, pencil, tees, and sand bottles. The two sand bottles on the power cart may only be used by the single cart rider (single cart rider protocol still in effect). Power cart coolers will not be introduced until further notice. Pull carts will also be equipped with sand bottles. Once more, all power carts/pull carts are sanitized with Sanicide disinfected solution.

With rounds increasing daily, so are divot counts. We respectfully ask that you fill your divots during play. Sand mix may be used on Bent Grass tees & fairways only. (Rough Excluded being Blue Grass Turf).

With the expansion of tee times we've already seen instances of no shows & last-minute cancellations. It is every member's responsibility to notify the Golf Shop of tee time cancellations/changes and provide all members the opportunity to access prime tee times. Please provide all participants names either online or by contacting the golf shop directly. In order to deliver the best possible service to all of you, it is paramount for the golf shop teammates and first tee attendants to know who's filling/playing in each tee time.

After speaking with several medical doctors whom are members of The Harvest Golf Club, the consistent message is wash your hands, sanitize but foremost avoid touching your face.
