CHERRIES

The Lapin cherries variety are now expected to be picked in between July 17 through the 20th almost two weeks later than usual (weather permitting). Okanagan cherry crops suffered severe damage this Spring after nighttime temperatures dropped to -8 Celsius in early April, this after the initial buddings had occurred destroying upwards of 50% of the crop in the process. Further damage has now been caused by the excessive amount of rain and much cooler temperature experienced these last six weeks. Mani Gill our orchard leasee is now expecting approximately 40/45 thousand pounds to be harvested.

Cherries can be purchased in boxes of 20 pounds only (same as years past) the cost of one box is \$60.00 or \$3.00 per pound. To place an order, please contact me personally and I will gladly add your name to our list. When ready, we will contact you to arrange day/time of pick up. Mode of payment; only cash or cheque will be accepted.
