We would like to thank all members as we have seen a noticeable improvement in the use of sand bottles on both driving and push carts. Additionally, rakes have been in the bunkers and ball marks are being fixed more regularly. We thank you for caring for your golf course, we ask that this remains so that conditions remain optimal as we move through the heat of the summer.

Course Condition Update: Rough Fertilization

From June 10th -12th all rough surfaces were fertilized. One may wonder why we would fertilize already lush surfaces following multiple rainfalls and ideal growing conditions. Simply put, fertilizer is nothing more than nutrients for the turf. This fertilizer application will be effective into the ground for a few months,

through the heat of the summer. You may see in the days and weeks to come an increase in rough turf density. However, assume as temperatures rise into the 30's for any substantial amount of time, rough will become progressively drier and leanier which makes playability more user friendly. This is because turf growth decelerates considerably when temperatures reach above 30 degrees.
