## **A Friendly Reminder:**

With the great increase in play, please take this as gentle reminder to all Harvest patrons that rakes go lateral to the hole inside the bunker. Additionally, please fix all ball marks on the green. A freshly fixed ball mark will be repaired within 24 hours, whereas a ball mark not repaired day of can take over a week to become healed. Finally, all carts both walking and riding are equipped with sand bottles. This is a mixture of mulch, sand, and seeds which should be utilized on tees, fairways and approaches if required. However, please avoid using the sand bottles in the rough and tee surrounds as these areas are bluegrass, and your divot should be replaced instead.

We will make every effort to ensure all guests are reminded of this as our sole goal is to ensure the best course conditions for you, our members.

We appreciate your cooperation in helping to maintain the golf course to the highest standards so that all can enjoy the course.
