

Golf Update

May 3rd

On Monday, May 4th, we will be performing a solid-tining aeration (small needles, no plug extraction) to our putting surfaces. This procedure is rendered necessary after bypassing hollow core aeration which was originally scheduled for Wednesday, April 15th. The solid-tining aeration process opens the pores of the turf allowing air, sunlight, nutrients and water to infiltrate the ground and feed the root system to ensure its long term health. This process does not affect playability and will only take a few days to heal completely.

Over the last couple of days with the addition of tee times which increased site visits, we've observed a few instances where social distancing was not abided by. Therefore, we would like to kindly remind you to please adhere to all protocols in place.

Now that we have re-introduced sand bottles to both power carts and pull carts to preserve course conditioning, we ask that you

please ensure to utilize sand bottles throughout your round to fill divots (tees & fairways only). Sand Bottles on power carts are to be used by the single rider only to mitigate touch points.

Overall, in the first two & half weeks of the season our Membership has been highly cooperative in following all protocols and measures. Your ongoing diligence is truly appreciated.
