**Sunday, November 8<sup>th</sup> to clarify the logic behind this selected playing format.**

1. With possible reoccurring daily frost in October, which often does not lift until 10:00/11:00am. Much like in April, and with Social Distancing in full effect, we need to prevent any form of large gatherings around the facility. Starting play at 11 am, will certainly help eliminate that possibility.
2. To ensure our members get to enjoy the best of the weather each day, which is normally in between 11am to 5pm.
3. After experiencing 3.5 hours rounds or less in the Spring, we believe if members adopt the same style of play approach (ready golf and continuous putting) groups of 6 players, amongst friends should result in manageable and enjoyable rounds of 4:15 hours.
4. As we are expecting demands for tee times to remain extremely high through closing day, and dealing with limited number of tee times due to daylight, 6-somes allows us to increase daily capacity by 50% or approximately 330 rounds weekly (the equivalent of creating three extra days of capacity each week).
5. Playing in 6-some is certainly unconventional, but we are navigating abnormal times where thinking outside the box is needed in creating additional spaces for club members to enjoy.
